The Yellowwood Trail is a cross-country footpath located in south-central Indiana and meanders for about 20 miles in Brown and Monroe counties over scenic ridges and picturesque valleys with the landscape varying from open country to dense forest.

Please help protect this trail. Camping and lighting fires along the trail route is not allowed. It is a violation of the law to destroy, injure or disturb any form of animal or plant life or any other natural features of the trail area. Much of the trail is on private land. Always submit a registration form to Trail Headquarters before hiking the trail.

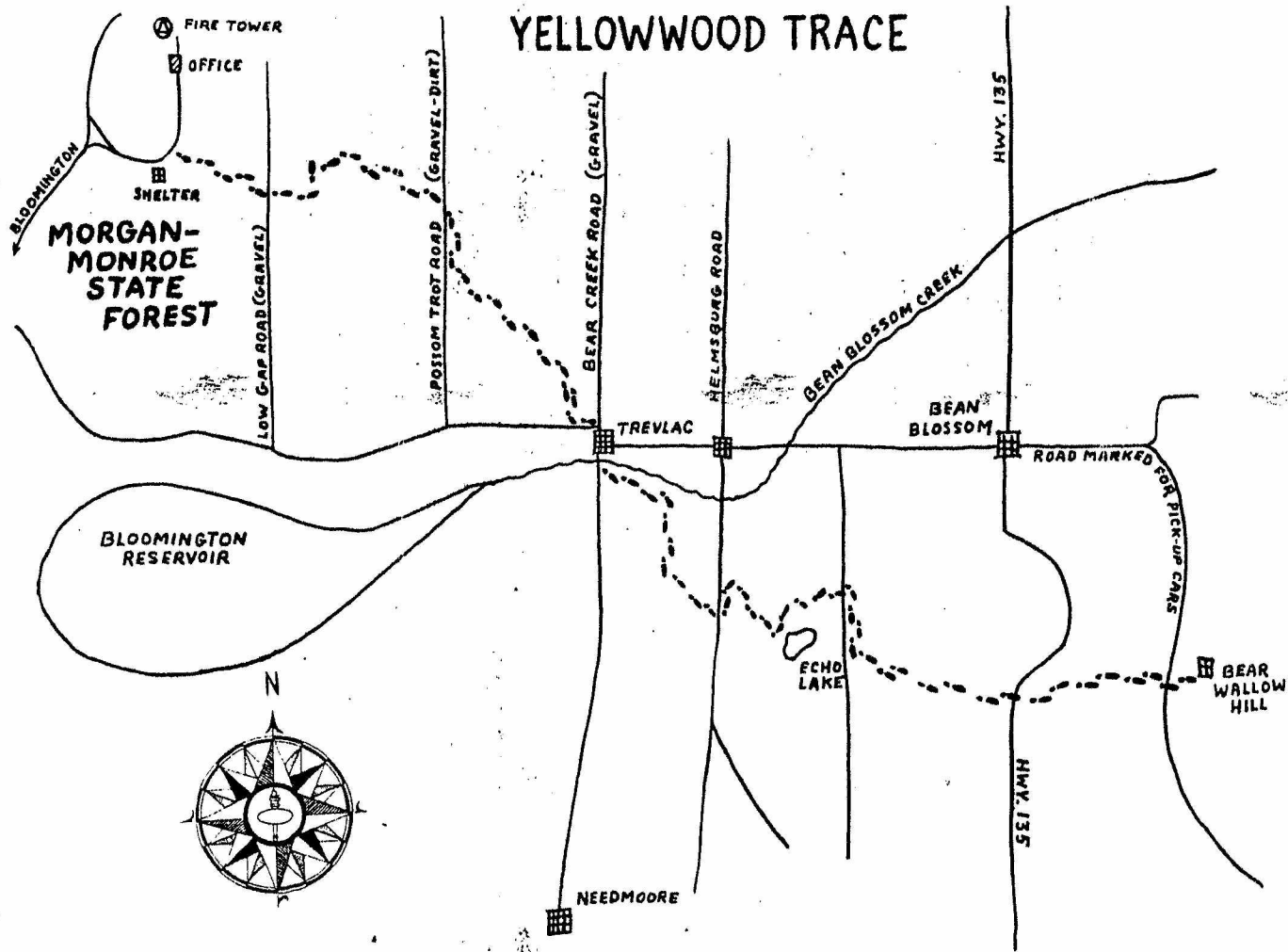
